

Victims of Trafficking

If you are seeking to block or remove adverse items from your background report that resulted from human trafficking, please provide the information below.

1. Proof of Identity
 - a. First, middle, and last name
 - b. Any previously used names
 - c. Address
 - d. Social Security Number
 - e. Date of Birth
 - f. Copy of a government issued ID

2. Trafficking Documentation
 - a. Provide victim determination documentation received from one or more of the following:
 - A Federal, State, or Tribal entity.
 - A non-governmental organization or human trafficking task force including victim service providers affiliated with these entities, authorized by a Federal, State, or Tribal government entity
 - A self-attestation that is signed or certified by a Federal, State, or Tribal government entity, court of competent jurisdiction, or an authorized representative of these entities.

3. List of Adverse Items of Information.
 - a. Provide a document that lists items of adverse information that you believe should not be included by a consumer reporting agency because the items results from a severe form of trafficking in persons or sex trafficking.

4. Your preferred method of written communication. This can be a mailing address or email address. All communication and final determination will be provided to you through your preferred method of communication.
