- 1. Proof of Identity
  - a. First, middle, and last name
  - b. Any previously used names
  - c. Address
  - d. Social Security Number
  - e. Date of Birth
  - f. Copy of a government issued ID
- 2. Trafficking Documentation
  - a. Provide victim determination documentation received from one or more of the following:
    - A Federal, State, or Tribal entity.
    - A non-governmental organization or human trafficking task force including victim service providers affiliated with these entities, authorized by a Federal, State, or Tribal government entity
    - A self-attestation that is signed or certified by a Federal, State, or Tribal government entity, court of competent jurisdiction, or an authorized representative of these entities.
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- 3. List of Adverse Items of Information.
  - a. Provide a document that lists items of adverse information that you believe should not be included by a consumer reporting agency because the items results from a severe form of trafficking in persons or sex trafficking.
- 4. Your preferred method of written communication. This can be a mailing address or email address. All communication and final determination will be provided to you through your preferred method of communication.
